Title:	Printing Press Machine Operator
Functional Area:	Printing Department
Reports to:	Marking Products Coordinator

Position Description: Responsible for operating and tending printing presses. Printing machine operator is a trained person who produces printed materials by following printing job specifications, setting up, operating, adjusting, and maintaining the printing equipment to ensure that it functions properly.

- Responsibilities & Essential Job Functions
 - Load, position, and adjust unprinted materials on holding fixtures or in equipment loading and feeding mechanisms.
 - Inspect and examine printed products for print clarity, color accuracy, conformance to specifications and external defects.
 - Examine job orders to determine details such as quantities to be printed, production times, stock specifications, colors, and color sequences.
 - Prepare machines for printing, run press with various size and color capabilities.
 - Ensure all safety devices are fully operational and safety procedures are being observed.
 - Pour or spread ink, color compounds, and other materials into reservoirs, troughs, hoppers, and make measurements and adjustments to control color and viscosity.
 - Ink the presses, load raw material, and adjust the press to required size.
 - Guide film through the press and adjust feed and tension controls.
 - Make adjustments to manage ink distribution, speed, and temperature.
 - Search for and correct problems.
 - Set up, monitor, and adjust the printing process on a control panel or computer monitor.
 - Remove printed materials from presses using electric lifts and hoists, and transport them to storage or finishing areas.
 - Oil and clean the press and make minor repairs.
