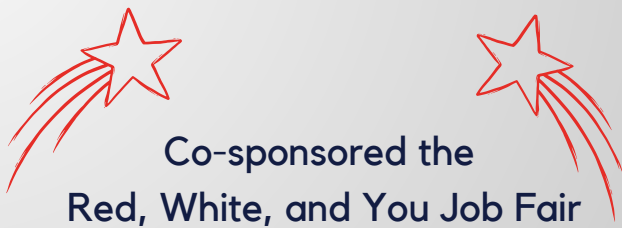

SEDCO and the Sherman Chamber of Commerce participated in the City of Sherman Christmas parade.



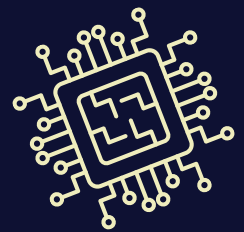
