- Resolution No. 2023.09 authorizing a sale of 6.309 acres in Progress Park V to Oncor Electric Delivery Company, LLC for \$360,000 for a new electric substation that is necessary to meet the demands of the Texas Instruments and GlobalWafers projects and future industrial customers.
- Resolution No. 2023.14 authorizing funding for GlobiTech,
 Inc. for a new product line of silicon carbide deposition on
 silicon wafers totaling \$100,500,000 which includes the
 purchase of 15 silicon carbide reactors, inspection
 equipment, building construction, building systems, and
 an exhaust system. The company currently employs 214
 active full-time employees.
- Resolution No. 2023.15 approving an agreement for civil engineering and surveying services with RLG Consulting Engineers for the design plan for infrastructure improvements in Progress Park.
